CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

Voluntary Contributions are non-compulsory charges that our school requests from parents/carers of students in Years 7 -10. The maximum contributions a school may charge is currently fixed at \$235.00 per student. These contributions are used to help supplement the Government funding that we receive and they are used to cover expenses for these students in their compulsory learning areas. To enable our school to provide up to date resources and equipment across these learning areas, we encourage all parents/carers to pay the voluntary contributions for their student.

In Years 7 – 10, charges are compulsory for all elective subjects outside our core learning areas. Our school offers these elective subject options to provide our students with the opportunity to participate in additional educational experiences. As these elective subjects are offered at the discretion of our school, they are not covered by Government Funding.

All subject costs for Years 11 and 12 are considered charges and therefore payment is compulsory.

Our school is only too aware that the payment of school contributions and charges can be a burden for some families. Payment plans are available to support parents or carers that are experiencing difficulties. COLLECTING CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

Our school takes a positive approach to collecting contributions and charges. Our school will actively seek the full payment of charges that are outstanding on student accounts.

- Account statements, outlining what is owing on student accounts is sent home each term.
- Our school will actively seek to contact our families, should any charges remain unpaid on their student's account.
- Outstanding charges are rolled over to the student's record in the following year.
- Compulsory charges that remain unpaid at the end of each school year will be referred to a debt collection agency.
- Parents who do not communicate with the school and have made no effort to pay unpaid charges will be referred to a debt collection agency as permitted in the regulations.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

Education Program Allowance (EPA)

The WA Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. The EPA is paid directly to the school and is applied to your student's compulsory charges first and then, if applicable, to the voluntary contributions. Parents and carers can elect to have the clothing allowance component paid either directly to them or to the school.

The allowance consists of two components:

- \$235.00 Education Program Allowance paid directly to the school to support payment of charges and voluntary contributions.

- \$115.00 Clothing Allowance paid either to the parent/guardian or directly to the school to support parents/guardians in purchasing school uniform.

Secondary Assistance Scheme applications must be made in-person at School Administration prior to **2nd April 2026**. You must present a valid concession card that has the student listed on it to complete the Secondary Assistance Scheme application. A new application needs to be made each year.

Late applications can only be made under certain extenuating circumstances.

PERSONAL ITEMS

Personal items refer to stationery, tools, workbooks and textbooks that students are required to bring to school to support their education. We expect all students to look after their pencil cases, files, equipment and tools – taking them home each day and returned the following day. These items should be stored safely – e.g., in a protective school bag.

Personal item lists are available on the school's website at ashs.wa.edu.au. Copies are also mailed home to parents/guardians with enrolled students in Term 4 each year. As the year progresses, certain items (including writing materials and other consumables) may need to be replaced.

You are not required to use the school's preferred supplier.

SMARTRIDERS

SmartRider Identification cards are ordered for all new students on commencement. The cost of the initial card is \$5.00. Replacement cards can be issued at the cost of \$5.00 per card.

UNIFORM

Our school uniform promotes our public image and enhances a sense of belonging in all members of our school community. All students are expected to wear the school's uniform.
